**Denise Verst** alias mathellaslife and her husband Hendrik Verst alias fitdad hendrik show their 600,000 plus followers the totally normal madness of a family of seven, from parenting and building a home to lifestyle topics. But not only that: since becoming so seriously ill that the young father needed a liver transplant in 2015, the couple have also used their reach to address the topic of organ donation.

Diagnosis: autoimmune hepatitis – and when you are just in your early thirties too. The world shattered for Hendrik and Denise Verst in 2015. At some point the medication stopped working and the patchwork family of four (at the time) were faced with an uncertain future. Would Hendrik get a new liver in time? Today, eight years after the diagnosis and two years after the transplant, the couple are processing the period of fear and hope in a book – moving, honest and insightful. With many statements that have never been shared before, it is a must read for their over 600,000 Instagram followers and for everyone interested in a personal account from an organ recipient and their family.
